**LOVE IN ACTION – FR. TOM COX**

On the road of life, not just Jerusalem to Jericho like our unfortunate traveller, you meet three types of people: users, avoiders and lovers. Give some time today to trying to figure out which one you are.

First, the robbers: they saw the man as someone to be used and exploited. They were 'users'.

Secondly, the priest and the Levite: they just walked by as they saw him as a problem to be avoided.

They were the 'avoiders'.

Finally, the Good Samaritan: he reached out to this wounded man. He was a lover.

So, what are you? Do you view people as means to an end? Plundering their talent and ability, feigning friendship? Or perhaps you think people are interruptions in your work, to be avoided? Or just maybe you're literally a people person, with a grá for them.

'Who is my neighbour?' as the impatient lawyer of Jesus. Good neighbours are valued, a rare treasure. The term 'Good Samaritan' rolls off our tongue so easily that we have forgotten that in Jesus' time a Good Samaritan was an oxymoron – a contradiction in terms. Maybe, just maybe, were a bit of an oxymoron – contradicting ourselves by our behaviour.
