SEAFIELD SAND DUNES BIODIVERSITY PLAN: Seafield Conservation Forum has received funding support from Community Finance Ireland to develop the first Community Biodiversity Action Plan for Seafield sand dunes. Developed by an expert ecologist, the plan will provide a blueprint of actions to guide sane dune restoration and conservation work over the next five years. Developing the plan is also an essential first step in fostering national stakeholder support and recognition for climate adaptation measures for Seafield. Addressing coastal erosion is essential, particularly given the pattern of coastal flooding projected to impact Seafield and the wider Kilmurry Ibrickane shoreline in the coming years. Once complete, Seafield Conservation Forum will share the contents of the Biodiversity Plan online.

THE OLD KILFARBOY SOCIETY: The final lecture of our winter series for 2023/24 will be held on Tuesday, 12th March 2024 and presented by Críostóir Mac Cárthaigh on The Sea and the Supernatural - Maritime Legends of the Clare Coast. Synopsis: A rich store of legends concerning encounters with supernatural beings and sightings of mystical islands off the coast of Clare has been preserved. The talk will explore a number of these remarkable traditions. Short biography: Críostóir Mac Cárthaigh is a former Director of the National Folklore Collection at University College Dublin. With a background in folklore and archaeology, he has written on different aspects of Irish oral literature, oral history, vernacular architecture, traditional boats and fishing. The cultural landscape of Atlantic island and coastal communities is of particular interest to him. He has edited a number of studies, including New Survey of Clare Island, Volume 1: History and Cultural Landscape (1999, co-edited with Kevin Whelan): Border-Crossing: Mumming in Cross-Border and Cross-Community Contexts (2007, co-edited with Séamas Ó Catháin, Séamus Mac Mathúna agus Anthony D. Buckley); and *Traditional Boats of Ireland* (2008). **Venue: The Malbay, Miltown Malbay.
