The situation faced by the people of Syria is a critical one with the country facing the worst humanitarian crisis in a generation. Tr caire is working in partnership with local church agencies in Syria and along neighbouring borders to support survivors. Since 2011, vital emergency aid has reached over 273,000 people.
