Yearly Supply of envelopes & Tax Back Scheme

We are currently doing envelopes for next year. If you have
not received them in the past and would like to please let the
parish office know. We thank all who use this system. It is
especially beneficial for use in the Revenue Tax Back Scheme.
Any parishioner who contributes over 250euros to all
collections in the year and pays this amount in their own taxes
is eligible. We would really encourage parishioners who do not
use the envelope system to consider doing so for 2017. This
would be of great assistance in increasing our returns on the
tax back refund system. Records are kept confidential and
the parish does not become aware of any individual's personal
tax circumstances. This is the only place in the Irish Tax
Code where people can directly nominate where their some of
their taxes go and at no cost or consequence to themselves!
We are preparing our tax back return and ask if you have
received one, could you return it to the Parish Office asap.
