**OIDHREACHT AN CHLÁIR** presents, as part of its IPB-funded Community Memories Project series, a video interview of the well-known singer PJ Murrhoy of Shandrum, Mullagh on Monday, November 12 at 8.30pm in The Malbay, Miltown Malbay. Interviewed by his daughter Moira, PJ shares vivid memories of farming life, days in the bog, saving hay, trapping hares on Mutton Island, and of hurling (as well as football) in Mullagh. He shows a reaping hook bought in 1778 in Kilrush, talks of piper Johnny Doran's visits and his impact locally, and of his own time with the Kilfenora Céilí Band and the Bannermen. PJ also tells the remarkable story of his neighbour Jane Hogan, reported lost in the torpedoing of the Lusitania in 1915 but who survived and walked home to Mullagh from Ennis.
