PREPARATION FOR THE INTERNATIONAL EUCCHARISTIC CONGRESS 2012

Join the journey to the 50th International Eucharistic Congress 2012 in Dublin – June 10 to June 17 2012. This journey is a time to prepare and reflect on our lives and the presence of God in our lives. The Eucharistic Congress Bell began its journey through the Dioceses of Ireland on St. Patrick's Day in 2011. Like St. Patrick's Bell, the Congress Bell is being rung across the land calling God's people to gather together, to hear the good news that God is present among us and calls us to Communion. The Bell will arrive in the Diocese of Killaloe on Monday 17 October and continue its pilgrimage through the Diocese for ten days. We invite Volunteers who are willing to carry the Bell, walk with the Bell, and pray with the Bell to a night of Catechesis and reflection in St Flannan's College Ennis, on Wednesday 14 September at 7.30pm. These Catechesis nights are open to everyone and we welcome and invite all who wish to participate in preparation for the Eucharistic Congress to attend.
