OIDHREACHT AN CHLÁIR: The next interviews in our Community Memories project, funded by the Heritage Council, will be shown on Monday, May 13 at 8.00pm in The Malbay, Miltown Malbay. Aidan Vaughan (interviewed by Tara Comber) recalls the Miltown of his youth, with the circus, travelling drama groups, cinemas and amusements, Miltown school and Ennistymon CBS, dancing classes, Clare Feiseanna, Miltown Fleadh, and the Clonbony Pipe Band where he learnt as a boy to play the drums. He talks of his years as drummer with the Briseadh na Lice, Laichtín Naofa, old Tulla and old Kilfenora and many other Céilí Bands, of his international travels as teacher and performer of set and sean-nós dancing, the regional variety in Clare dancing styles, and the importance of teaching the fundamental steps.

The late and fondly remembered Francis Comber of Carhuligane, Mullagh, interviewed by Aoibheann and Déirdre Comber three months before his death, traces his father's arrival from Ennistymon over a century ago and shares his memories of the tough farming life of his youth, the eight pubs and eight shops then in Mullagh, the monthly fairs there, the importance of the horse in rural life, daily journeys to the creamery (which had 375 suppliers at the time), and the making of puddings from the killing of the pig. He recalls giving rides on his pony to fellow-pupils for a penny, raiding beehives, amusing anecdotes of local characters and events, and his brief period working in London, and he talks of customs to be observed on visiting a house and of pisreogs still current in his time.
