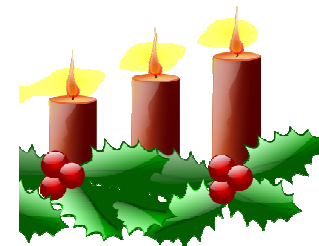

## Year of Mercy

Last Tuesday 8th December, Pope Francis Officially opened the extraordinary Holy Year of Mercy. This Sunday it will begin in our Diocese of Killaloe with the opening of the door of mercy in the Cathedral in Ennis and in the Cistercian Monastery in Roscrea. The theme of this year is 'Merciful like the Father'

This year of mercy is an opportunity for all of us to celebrate mercy, to live mercy, to grow in mercy and be transformed by mercy. Our world can be so harsh and cruel. This year allows us to open our eyes to the mercy which surrounds us and on which we depend. A banner is on display in each of the churches. It features the theme 'Merciful like the Father Luke 6.36' and the holy year logo. The logo is the work of Fr. Marko Rupnik S.J. The good shepherd, in his great mercy, carries humanity on his shoulders. The eyes of Christ are merged with those of humanity. Christ sees with our eyes and we are called to see with the eyes of Christ. Every person discovers in Christ, the new Adam, his/her own humanity and future by contemplating the love of God the Father. The scene is captured with three concentric ovals, with colours progressively lighter as we move outward, suggest the movement of Christ who carried humanity out of darkness into eternal light.

Holy Year prayer cards featuring the Holy Year logo and a prayer for the holy year written by Pope Francis are available. They can be used as a prayer and reflection for the year ahead.
