It was produced by the Transition Year Students 2007/08 of Scoil Mhuire, Ennistymon. They undertook this project by writing to some of "Who's Who" in Irish life and to the local people of North Clare requesting them to submit their favourite prayer/scripture reading and the reason they chose it. The project was in response to the work of two local retired teachers who were working as volunteers on Pemba Island, Tanzania an area where the level of education is exceptionally low. They got involved in the building of a nursery school which is under the auspice of the Diocese of Zanzibar but which will provide vital education for Christian and Muslim children together in Pemba. Work has already begun on the building of the nursery and Scoil Mhuire TY class hope to make a presentation of the proceeds from the sale of this book to Fr Msaky CSSp, the only priest on the island when he visits Ireland in September.
