FEAST OF ST. SWITHIN

St. Swithin an Anglo-Saxon bishop of Winchester who lived in the 9th century. He was famous for his charitable works. According to tradition, on his death bed, he requested to be buried outside where passers-by could walk over his grave and raindrops fall upon it. Nine years later the shrine was built inside Winchester Cathedral for his remains. On 15th July 971 during the ceremony, it started to rain and continued for another forty days. It is also said if St. Swithin’s feast is fine, it will continue for forty days.
