The indigenous Indians, living in the upper regions of the Andes, live on subsistence farming and in housing conditions (mud huts, thatched roofs, no windows) akin to pre famine Ireland. But they seem to have enough to eat - potatoes being the staple diet. Your generous contributions were spent as follows: Concern €5,200, Fr. Chris Conroy (worked for fifteen years with the Andean Indians) €2,350 and I distributed €600 myself, the beneficiaries being two schools and families living in extreme poverty.
