TRÓCAIRE: The difference your money can make this year in Trócaire's work around the world. There are high levels of hunger in Zomba, Malawi and a widespread food crisis. This is due to crop failure and continuing unpredictable rainfall. The main crop planted in Zomba is maize and when this fails many people have nothing else to fall back on. The aim of this project is to improve the reliability of food sources in rural Zomba so that people will have enough food and also enough seeds to plant. Many of the farmers are women. By working with farmers to help them improve their land, their practises and how they manage water; the project seeks to provide more food for families. It also provides better seeds and some livestock. The cost of this project for poor farmers is €7,314.
