### Community Led Liturgy

We will have a community led liturgy on Saturday 23rd and Sunday 24th February in all the Churches. It is vital that we prepare for the future so we ask for your support.

**What is Community Led Liturgy? Why is it being introduced?** We need to prepare now for the changes that lie ahead for our parishes and Christian Communities. With declining numbers of priests, we need to ensure that each parish and Christian Community is resourced 'to assemble its members, proclaim the Gospel and pray as a Community'. This means training lay people to lead liturgical celebrations on Sundays and weekdays when the need arises. People are already being trained for this ministry in many parts of our diocese.

**Why are we doing this when there are still so many priests in the Diocese?** We are blessed at present to have so many priests still ministering in our parishes. But the reality we must face is that we no longer have priests to replace those who leave a parish through illness or death. Some parishes in our diocese are sharing priests and this will become more and more a reality as time goes on.

**But I thought only a priest could lead the liturgy?** Only a priest can lead the celebration of the Eucharist but in circumstances where a priest is unavailable to preside at the Eucharist, a Community Led Liturgy of the Word with Holy Communion may be led by lay people who have been trained and authorised by the Diocese to do so.
