We are workers. It helps now and then to step back and take the long view. The kingdom is not only beyond our efforts, it is even beyond our vision.

Archbishop Oscar Romera was Bishop of San Salvador. He was a great defender of the poor. He constantly spoke out for justice and against violence. Like Christ he called both rich and poor to forgiveness and conversation. He was assassinated as he celebrated mass on 24 March 1980. The blood of martyrs is the seed of Christians. He will be beatified next weekend in El Salvador.
