We work within the framework from the National Board for Safeguarding Children in the Catholic Church and the Children First 2011, National Guidance for the Protection and welfare of children.

While it is not possible to prevent all violence, nor possible to guarantee that no child will ever be harmed by neglect or aggression or exploitation or predation, it is our duty to do everything in our power as a Government and as a society to prevent such harm."
