ÉIGSE THOMÁIS UÍ AODHA, 2023: The 5th annual Irish-language festival, organised by Oidhreacht an Chláir in memory of Miltown man Tomás Ó hAodha (1866-1935), poet, dramatist, actor, choirmaster, cartographer and Gaeilge activist, will be held on October 6-7, in Áras OaC (Flag Road), Miltown. On Friday 6th at 8.00pm, Dr Críostóir Mac Cárthaigh (recently retired Director of the National Folklore Collection) will give a lecture, *Ag Taifeadh Scéalaíochta agus Seanchais in Iarthar an Chláir, 1950*, dealing with the recording of storytelling and folklore in West Clare in 1950. There will also be an exhibition of the personal Archive (Cartlann) of Tomás Ó hAodha. Ó 3.00pm to 5.30pm, beidh *Ceol agus Caint* i Friel's, featuring a Pop-Up Gaeltacht as an opportunity for people to use their Irish, amhráin le MacDara Ó Conaola agus Tim Dennehy, agus ceol le Eithne Ní Dhonghaile (cruit), John Canny (bosca ceoil) agus John Weir (fíidil). Gabhaimid buíochas le Foras na Gaeilge agus le Comhairle Contae an Chláir as a dtacaíocht. All events are free. Míle fáilte roimh chách.
