**WE ARE HAVING A COMMUNITY LED LITURGY ON
SATURDAY 7TH AND SUNDAY 8TH OF SEPTEMBER.**

What is Community Led Liturgy? Why is it being introduced?

We need to prepare now for the changes that lie ahead for our
parishes and Christian Communities. With declining numbers
of priests, we need to ensure that that each parish and
Christian Community is resourced 'to assemble its members,
proclaim the Gospel and pray as a Community'. This means
training lay people to lead liturgical celebrations on Sundays
and weekdays when the need arises. People are already being
trained for this ministry in many parts of our diocese.

**If there was no Mass in my parish on a Sunday, I think I'd go
to the parish next door?** From the earliest times gathering to
pray as a Community on Sundays has been at the very heart of

the Christian life. Even if a priest is unavailable to be with
them, the Christian Community can continue to gather as the
praying community in its own place. If each person decides to
go to the neighbouring parish this will have a big impact on
the identity of our local parishes. For this reason, the Diocese is
committed to training Lay Leaders of Liturgy so that Christian
Communities can gather to pray in their own parishes.

What will Community Led Liturgy look like? How will it differ
from Mass? Many of the elements of a Community Led
Liturgy will be familiar. We will gather as a Community in
much the same way as we do each Sunday. We will listen
together to the Word of God and pray for the needs of the
world and Church and the needs of our neighbours in the
Prayer of the Faithful. In the absence of a presiding priest the
Liturgy of the Eucharist where we take, bless, break and share
the Eucharistic elements is not celebrated. Instead, Holy
Communion consecrated at a previous Eucharist is brought to
the altar and distributed by those trained and commissioned in
the parish as Eucharistic Ministers After Communion a prayer
of thanksgiving is prayed. Any announcements are made at
this point also. All of this is done prayerfully and with great
reverence.
