This is an aerial video (by drone) of the following three sites of historical interest in this area, with on-site commentary from Cyril Jones and Michael Falsey: the reputed site of the Cathair stone fort, north of the Church, from which Sráid na Cathrach is named; the Freagh Castle Coastguard Station, where John Philip Holland (inventor of the submarine) served as boatman from 1831 to 1849; and the Quilty and Seafield coastline, focusing on the little-known Irish names of its physical features).
