MESSAGE FROM THE AMBULANCE SERVICE: We all carry mobile phones with names and numbers stored in its memory. If we were involved in an accident or taken ill, the people attending us would have our mobile phones but wouldn't know who to call. Yes, there are hundreds of numbers stored but which one is the contact person in case of emergency? Hence this "**ICE**" (In Case of Emergency) Campaign. It is a method of contact during emergency situations. All you need to do is store the number of a contact person or persons who should be contacted during an emergency under the name "**ICE**". For more than one contact name, simply enter ICE1, ICE2, ICE3 etc. In an emergency situation, Emergency Service personnel and hospital staff would be able to quickly contact the right person by simply dialling the number you have stored as "**ICE**".
