When the Egyptians treated us harshly and afflicted us, by imposing hard labour on us, we cried to the LORD...and he brought us into this place and gave us this land, a land flowing with milk and honey. e (Deuteronomy 26:6-7,9) As the Israelites suffered at the hands of the Egyptians, they appealed to the Lord for comfort and assistance, in the way that we would pray to God during times of turmoil and insecurity, asking him to lead us towards our land of 'milk and honey.'
