The person has used a version of the Diocesan office stationery, and with Bishop O'Reilly's signature, both of which may appear to be authentic, to confirm the order. The Diocesan Office wishes to appeal to all traders across the County, but in the town of Ennis in particular, not to accept any such orders without returning calls to the office land – line for verification, and not, under any circumstances, to deliver goods to another premises for collection.
