- 3. Families are welcome to sit together, two people per seat from different households (seated on either side of the seat) Stewards will guide you to your place.
- 4. Eucharistic Ministers will wear face masks and sanitise hands before giving out Holy Communion, we ask you if possible to receive Holy Communion on your hand.
