The last group game was against Kilmacud Crokes in what was one of the games of the tournament. First half goals from Caitlin O'Connor (2) Sophie Daly & Joanna Doohan had KIB a goal up at half time against a very good Dublin outfit and in a tense second half a late goal by Kilmacud saw them through on a scoreline of 5-4 to 4-4. This resulted in a 3rd place finish in the group and a Round 4 match vs Bennekerry/Tinryland from Carlow and in a tight contest KIB prevailed on a scoreline of 3-6 to 2-4, goalscorers for KIB were Rachel Tubridy & Sophie Daly (2). Next up were a very talented Eire Og Cork in the Plate 1/4 Final and despite goals from Joanna Doohan & Rachel Tubridy, Eire Og were just too strong and won out on a scoreline of 7-4 to 2-5. The girls played some fantastic football and the experience of playing against some of the best footballers in the country will no doubt stand to them in the future. In our third game we played Cornafean (Cavan) which saw us win 3 from 3 on a score line of 8-10 to 2-5. Our fourth and final round game was an exciting battle with worthy opponents Bearnna (Galway), who needed a win to stay in the competition, with outstanding performances from all the KIB panel we won 2-17 to 4-4 to top our group and progress to the Cup Semi Final. Unfortunately this game saw our tournament come to an end, losing to a strong Parnells team from London who went on to win the All Ireland Intermediates Cup.
