From 18th-25th January is the week of prayer for **Christian Unity**

This week was first observed in New York in 1908. The theme chosen this year is: called to proclaim the mighty Acts of the Lord.

'But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's own people, in order that you may proclaim the mighty acts of him who called you out of darkness into his marvellous light. Once you were not a people, but now you are God's people, once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.'

BEREAVEMENT TRAINING:

When bereaved, most people cope with the support from family and friends, however some people will require help. With this in mind a training programme for parishes has been developed. This course offers insight into a broad range of concerns around the dynamics of grief and loss. It is the intention of this training to provide knowledge and structure to those in their local community. The four nights will encompass (1) General Principles of Bereavement Support (2) The way people grieve (3) Responses to loss & Coping with Grief (4)Setting up a bereavement group. A bereavement group is a voluntary parish based ministry where the objective is to support the bereaved through the grieving process. The training will be provided free of charge and will benefit those who have a passion in coming to the assistance of those bereaved.
