Re: Slieve Callan Fund. 19th Jan. 2021

Kilmurry Ibrickane Development Committee has recently appointed an architect to progress the design and planning permission for a new Sports / Community and Tourism Centre in the village. Over the past few years, considerable research on the project idea has been undertaken and grant and other funding options pursued by the oluntary committee. In order to attract grant funding for "bricks and mortar" at a new Centre, an architectural design and planning permission is needed. Thus, this first design stage is necessary in order to make the project "shovel ready" for building and grants. Engineering surveys have also been progressed recently. Public consultation in the community will now commence on the designs. It is expected that the sports facility will be prioritised subject to funding. Guidance and support have been provided to date from Kilmurry Ibrickane GAA, Clare County Council, TOMAR Trust have come up with a substantial amount of Monies to progress with the Architectural Design and Government Departments and professional experts are also on Board.

Due to Covid 19 2020 this project was on hold and its now on the move for 2021
