The 5th annual Irish-language festival, organised by Oidhreacht an Chláir in memory of Miltown man Tomás Ó hAodha (1866-1935), poet, dramatist, actor, cartographer and Gaeilge activist, will be held on October 6-7, in Áras OaC (Flag Road), Miltown. On Friday 6th at 8.00pm, Dr Criostóir Mac Cárthaigh (recently retired Director of the National Folklore Collection) will give a lecture, Ag Taifeadh Scéalaíochta agus Seanchais in Iarthar an Chláir, 1950, dealing with the recording of storytelling and folklore in West Clare in 1950.
