Thursday marked 100 days since the disaster and Trócaire's work continues thanks to the kind donations of parishes all over the country. In all over €6 million was given to Trócaire and already, working with the Caritas network, 900,000 people have been provided with shelter. Over one million euro has been given to health care. Over one-and-a-half million people have been given regular food supplies or hot meals. Over 200,000 people have already been given access to clean water or have been provided with hygiene kits.
