This Christmas time let us take a moment to ponder, to salute, to greet, to express good wishes and to make a space for the Christ Child through each other. To all, I wish a very happy Christmas, be you regular church goer, occasional church goer, or non- church goer. May you find solace and joy. May you feel welcome and appreciated for who you are. I offer a sincere thanks to all who continue to keep our parish community and church life vibrant. May the sharing of your time, talents, suggestions, challenges and quiet presence be blessed by the Christ Child this Christmas.
