#### Precautions in Relation to Swine Flu:

Following consultation with the HSE the bishops have made the following recommendations in relation to all church gatherings:

- People with symptoms of influenza - colds, coughs, sneezing etc. - are advised to avoid such gathering until symptoms disappear. There is no obligation to attend Mass whenever a person is ill.
- Receiving Communion on the tongue can constitute a risk for both recipient and for others. While no one for whom reception on the tongue is important will be refused it is recommended that we take the sacred host on the hand while the threat of flu persists.
- Sign of Peace: while the handshake at the sign of peace is not regarded a risk some people may prefer to substitute a gesture such as a smile or nod. If people feel more strongly about the matter the priest might simply say "we pause for a moment in silent prayer for peace".
