Roots and wings

There's the old saying about the family – families give us roots and wings, a place of departure and a place of return.

And it was like that for Jesus, Mary and Joseph.

In the temple Jesus realised that his family was bigger than his home and extended family; that his responsibility was not just to his family, but to God.

And isn't it like that for all of us? Children move from being totally dependent to finding their own way through life, with new relationships, growing old enough eventually to make their own decisions and moving out to form their own families; searching from within the faith handed on to them to find a faith that is their own.

Changes in New Year Anniversary Masses
