Trócaire's 6th Parish Bulletin

"My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" (Psalm 21:9-9)

Today's psalm could be the caption to so many of the images we have been presented with by Trócaire this Lent. Indeed, we can, relate to this in asking "My God, My God, why have you forsaken *them*?" as we wonder, time and time again, why there is so much suffering in the world, an particularly this Lent, why so many people are *still* hungry.

There are now one billion hungry people in the world - more than the combined populations of the European Union, United States & Canada. The bitter irony is that there is enough food in the world to feed the population just no political will to eradicate hunger. Trócaire is now calling on the government to outline its progress in those areas during the UN Millennium Summit in September, when world leaders will report on progress on the Millennium Development Goals to which they signed up to ten years ago. The first goal set out to halve the number of people living in hunger by 2015.
