LEARNING ABOUT THE MASS WITH KATH AND QUMEN
WHO DOES WHAT AT MASS (1)? At every Mass you will notice that some members of the assembly have different jobs. We call these jobs 'ministries'. Let's look at some of them: **THE PRIEST:** At Mass the priest leads us and encourages us to play our part in the celebration. How does he do this? He:

- Leads us in prayer
- Invites us to listen to God's word
- Helps us to understand and make sense of the Word of God in our daily lives through his homily
- Takes our gifts, the bread and wine, offers them to God and prays that by the power of the Holy Spirit they will become the body and blood of Jesus Christ.



THE SERVERS: Servers are normally boys and girls who have received their First Communion. Their job is to help the priest during Mass. They can carry books, bring water and wine, wash the priest's hands and ring bells.

MINISTER OF THE WORD: Even though we sometimes call this person the reader, the proper name is 'Minister of the Word'. The readings of Mass come from the Bible. They are the Word of God and so we can say that we hear God speaking to us through the voice of the Minister of the Word.

FEAST OF ALL SAINTS: Thursday 1st November is the Feast of All Saints. It is a Holy Day of Obligation. Mass times are as follows—Vigil Quilty on Wednesday at 7pm, Mullagh on Thursday at 11am & Coore on Thursday at 8pm.

FEAST OF ALL SOULS: Wednesday 2nd November is the Feast of All Souls. This is the day when we pray and remember in a special way those who have died, who have gone before us in Faith. Envelopes for lists of your beloved dead are available in the Porches and we ask you to return these next weekend.

FIRST FRIDAY: Friday next is the First Friday in November. Mass times on Friday are as follows – Mullagh 12noon. Quilty 7pm. Coore 8pm. An opportunity for the Sacrament of Reconciliation is available before each Mass. Fr. Pat will make his calls on Thursday 1st & Friday 2nd.

BLESSING OF GRAVES: November is a special time when we remember our loved ones. We will have the blessing of graves during the month of November - **Sunday 4th November:** Coore Graveyard after 9.30am Mass & Mullagh Graveyard after 11am Mass. **Sunday 11th November:** Quilty Graveyard at 2pm & Kilmurry Graveyard afterwards. **Sunday 18th November:** Kilbridget Graveyard after 11am Mass & Knocknahilla Graveyard at 3pm.

MASS OF REMEMBRANCE: The Annual Mass of Remembrance for all those who died in the past year will take place in Mullagh Church on Tuesday 27th November at 8pm. In this celebration we pray and remember all who were buried in the Parish over the past 12 months. We also remember family members who died and were buried away from the Parish.
