BISHOP FINTAN: This coming week a series of conversations will be held in different locations around the Diocese, hosted by Bishop Fintan. The conversation for our pastoral area will be in Carrigroan Day Centre on Wednesday 7th November at 7.30pm. Each evening is about conversation or Comhrá, as is said as Gaeilge. Caint agus Comhrá. The conversations are not about structures or decisions about the future. We have gathered a lot about that and it has been good. However, this evening is about listening to each other to see where we are at. How we feel as people of faith and communities or faith, at this time. They offer space to think and talk together. Much has happened in recent months that has impacted on our faith and on our faith communities. It is good to take time to reflect on that, to notice how we feel, to pay attention to how we have been encouraged or discouraged in our faith journey. Pope Francis is constantly calling us to be a Church which listens, a Church which discerns together, listening to the call of God in what is happening. Our model is the story of the two disciples on the road to Emmaus. As they talked and discussed the things which had happened, they came to recognise that Jesus walked with them along the road. A warm invitation is extended to everyone to be part of the conversation.
