## Kilmurry Ibrickane Development Committee Notice

Over the last number of weeks and months a process was started regarding the use of the Slieve Callan Fund which culminated in some major decisions being made this week by the Kilmurry Ibrickane Development Committee. Submissions were invited through this Newsletter from groups or associations or committees from our Parish seeking financial assistance for their chosen project. There were five entries in total and they were from the Quilty Action Group, Mullagh School Astro Turf, Kevin Giltenan San Marcos Project, Kilmurry Ibrickane Parochial Hall and Kilmurry Ibrickane GAA Indoor Arena. The five submissions were of an exceptionally high standard, innovative, imaginative and worthwhile and we would like to thank all the individuals and groups for making such a massive effort. It is very much appreciated. Ultimately decisions had to be made and the Development Committee decided to progress with one major capitol project and a capitol project. The Parochial Hall in Mullagh has served our Parish well for generations and continues to do so right up to today. However essential work needs to be carried out so the Committee are delighted to announce that €30,000 has been allocated to the Kilmurry Ibrickane Parochial Hall so that a new toilet block will be installed and that the heating system can be brought up to the required standard for our Parishioner's. This money will be made available as soon as possible so that work can begin once certain criteria are followed and processed. It is expected that the project regarding the Parochial Hall will be started and completed by the end of this year. The Development Committee are also delighted to announce that the Kilmurry Ibrickane GAA proposal to develop an indoor arena on it's grounds will be the chosen Major Capitol Project. This building when completed will be suitable for a wide spectrum of Community activities from Indoor Soccer, Basketball, Keep Fit Classes to Concerts, School events and all other social gatherings. It will be built for the Community. It is envisaged that a gym and sauna will be provided in the complex as will a large space upstairs to develop a café or restaurant, tourist shop and other amenities so that tourists travelling on the Wild Atlantic Way will stop and visit our Parish. In the not too distant future, it may also provide employment opportunities for some of our Parishioner's even on a seasonal basis. To initiate the project the Development Committee are also delighted to announce an initial allocation of €70,000 this year and €20,000 every year for the next five years to the Kilmurry Ibrickane GAA. This will enable the project to get underway and seek additional funding from other sources as well as undertake local fundraising to complete the project. If this strategy is successful, it will permit more funding to become available for other developments in the parish in time. The total cost to build the Indoor Arena is approximately €245,000. For the record the total Slieve Callan Fund is €378,000 over 25 years so clearly there will be funds available for other projects down the road. To the Quilty Action Group, Mullagh School Astro Turf and Kevin Giltenan's San Marcos Project, we say thank you for contributing so much and rest assured your entries are being kept on file. There is tremendous goodwill to your particular ideas and if extra funds do become available, we will be looking on your requirements favourably. As a Development Committee we intend to work closely on these projects whether it's helping to organise Fundraising events or pursue grant allocation. It is not every Parish in Ireland that will try to undertake two worthwhile projects at the same time. I appeal to every Kilmurry Ibrickane man, woman and child to stand together with us and get behind these projects in a positive and passionate way. Thank you for your wonderful support.
