Norms for Indulgences at the Commemoration of All Souls

From 12noon on the 1st November until midnight on the 2nd November, all who have confessed, received Holy Communion, and prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father, and Hail Mary, or any other of one's choice) can gain on plenary indulgence by visiting a Church and there reciting the Our Father and the Apostles Creed. This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the departed. Confession may be made any time within the week preceding or the week following the 1st November. Holy Communion may be received on any day from 1st-8th November. The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to Holy Souls on the usual conditions once per day from 1st-8th November. The conditions mentioned above apply also for this.
