Is Mass Changing?

The structure of the Mass is not changing. Its order and the actions of the Mass remain unchanged. The readings at Mass are not changed. However, with the introduction of the new edition of Roman Missal we will notice a change in how the Mass sounds. The translations of a significant number of our prayer texts from the original Latin have changed - sometimes by just a change in a particular word or in the word order. Prayers that we are used to hearing the Priest say will sound different to us. The style of language we will hear and pray may seem more formal to us and perhaps, in parts, more complex. But over time, with the praying of these texts, the sound of the Mass will again become familiar to us.

WALKING THE CLARE PILGRIM WAY: A project aimed at developing a Clare Pilgrim Way around the periphery of Clare, linking the significant 'holy' places of Clare has been in discussion for some time. For four days this August, a group will undertake Stage 1 of this pilgrim way, walking from St Senan's Well in Mollougha, Killimer, the birthplace of Senan of Scatterry, to Kilfenora, the city of the High Crosses and the site of the early monastic settlement founded by St. Fachtna in the sixth century. The itinerary for the four day walk is as follows: **Day 1:** Thursday 11 August: St. Senan's Well, Molougha, Killimer to St Senan's Altar, Doonbeg, via Kilrush. **Day 2:** Friday 12 August: St. Senan's Altar, Doonbeg to Spanish Point, via Killard: coastal walk to Spanish Point. **Day 3:** Saturday 13 August: Spanish Point to Cathedral, Kilfenora via Kilfarboy, and Cahersherkin. **Day 4:** Sunday 14 August: Cathedral, Kilfenora to St Brigid's Well, Liscannor, via Kilshanny and Kilmacreehy. A core group will complete this walk

but anyone can participate at any point along the way. In conjunction with the pilgrim walk, on Thursday night, August 11, a radio documentary on the life of St Senan, focusing especially on his journeys to Europe, will be presented by its producer Mr Ray Conway in the Kilkee Bay Hotel, beginning at 8 p.m. Further details later about these events later.
