OIDHREACHT AN CHLÁIR: The next video interview from our Community Memories project, funded by the Heritage Council, will be shown as set out below in The Malbay, Miltown Malbay on Monday, April 1 at 8.00pm. Michael Meade of Fintra (interviewed by Neil Hynes) recalls the hardship of farming life in his youth, especially in 1946-7, including walking cattle to and from Ennis, Kilmihil and Ennistymon fairs and to Carron for winterage; his life as an emigrant in 1960s Manhattan working on the construction of Madison Square Garden and the Twin Towers; the Miltown Social Club in New York and its major donations for projects at home; and his later return to livestock farming locally. He talks of his football career here and in New York and his later vital role as trainer of the All-Ireland champion Miltown, Clare and Spanish Point ladies' football teams, as well as sharing memories of social life and characters in earlier times.
