Thank You From Pakistan Floods Emergency

It is now three months since devastating floods hit Pakistan and Trócaire has expressed sincere thanks to everyone that supported its emergency appeal. Over the past few months people have generously donated over €5.5million to help survivors of the disaster. Almost half of this.

€2.5million was raised as a result of the church collections that were held around the country in August.
