Return to Public Masses

We are concerned for the safety of everybody so at a recent Pastoral Council meeting we decided on the following safety measures:

- Hand sanitisers are available at each church.
- We ask you to avail of these as you enter the Church.
- If you wish you may stay in your car and listen to mass on outside speaker and we will bring you Holy Communion.
- We ask you to adhere to social distancing by being aware of the signs on the floor.
- Families are welcome to sit together, two people per seat from different households (seated on either side of the seat). Stewards will guide you to your place.
- Eucharistic Ministers will wear face masks and sanitise hands before giving out Holy Communion.
- Speakers are installed outside so if anybody wants to stay outside they are welcome to do that too.
- Because of Covid 19 we won't be passing around the baskets for our collection as usual. Baskets will be placed at each church door so that you can place your contributions in them.
- We ask people to receive Holy Communion on the hand if at all possible. If there are people seated in the gallery please stay there. A Eucharistic Minister will come up to you.
- We will leave the Church in stages beginning with the right-hand side aisle continuing with the left-hand side aisle and followed by the main aisle.

ÉIGSE THOMÁIS UÍ AODHA, 2021: The 3rd annual Irish-language festival, organised by Oidhreacht an Chláir in memory of Tomás Ó hAodha, will be held on October 8-9, in the Community Centre, Miltown. On Friday 8th at 8.00pm, Dr Eilís Ní Dheá will give a lecture, *Oidhreacht na Scríobhaithe in Uí Bhreacáin* (The Heritage of the Scribes in Ibrickane), focusing on poet and scribe Aindrias Mac Cruitín of Moyglass (1650-1738). On Saturday 9th, 10.30-12.00 noon, there will be a *Ceardlann Amhránaíochta* (Singing Workshop) by Nollaig Ní Laoire from Ráth Chairn, winner of Corn Uí Riada in 2010. From 2.30pm to 5.00pm, there will be *Ceol agus Caint* in Michael A's bar (open-air area), featuring a Pop-Up Gaeltacht as an opportunity for people to use their Irish, songs by Nollaig Ní Laoire, Tim Dennehy and Róisín White, and music by Martha and Geraldine Clancy. FCJ SPIRITUALITY HOUSE, SPANISH POINT: For decades the FCJ sisters have loved to come to Ibricken Lodge for summer holidays and retreats. Their summer home near the Armada is spoken about with great love and affection across the international community. Now they would like to share their home with the wider community – offering events and courses across the winter for locals and those who might come to Clare seeking a quiet healing place away from the bustle of life. The sisters will be back each summer, but would love the house to be a calm haven for all across the rest of the year. The sisters have asked Nóirín Lynch to lead this project on their behalf. This commemoration is in memory of the Volunteers of the 4th Battalion West Clare Brigade, Irish Republican Army 1919-1921, from A /Company Mullagh, B/Company Coore, C/Company Knocknahilla, D/Company Kilmurry Ibrickane, E/Company Quilty and their comrades in Cumann na mBán. The keynote speaker will be Eoin Shanahan author of 'The hand that held the gun'. All are welcome to attend as we remember and commemorate the great fortitude, strength and spirit of these brave men and women, our own predecessors and those of our neighbours one hundred years later.
