We don't think of it as a place of life, yet in the tomb Jesus was called from the coldness of death to the warmth of new life, from the emptiness of death to the fullness of new consolation, from the dread of nothingness to the confidence of new mission.

The clothes left behind, rolled up, never to be used again. For life is new, and on a new day we wear new clothes.

The clothes of death give way to the bright colours of resurrection, and injustice gives way to care and compassion, hurt and violence to reconciliation. The hand of friendship is stretched out to another, and people just try to make it together.

Old clothes no longer needed, angers long smouldering put out with new hope, new life and a new vision of God. And fears once crippling new life evaporate into confidence the wearers are raised to new life, new love and work for God.
