Blessed Mother Teresa was born Agnes Gonxha Bojaxhiu in 1910 to an ethnic Albanian family. Mother Teresa came to Ireland to train as a Loreto Sister, before she was sent on mission to India in 1929. She began her missionary work with the poor and laid the foundation for what would become the Missionaries of Charity. Following her death in 1997, Saint John Paul 11 waived the usual five-year waiting period and allowed the opening of the process to declare her sainthood. She was beautified in 2003.
