O'Reilly was working as a farm labourer on Jersey when the Channel Islands were occupied by the Germans in July 1940. Two years later he joined German Military Intelligence and in December 1943 he parachuted from a German aircraft landing at Moveen, near Kilkee. He continued to work covertly for the Germans and was eventually detained at Arbour Hill Military Prison by the Irish authorities. All are welcome!
