We warmly welcome everybody back. We are concerned for the safety of everybody so at a recent Pastoral Council meeting we decided on the following safety measures:

1. Hand sanitisers are available at each church. We ask you to avail of these as you enter the Church.
2. We ask you to adhere to social distancing by being aware of the signs on the floor.
3. Families are welcome to sit together, two people per seat from different households (seated on either side of the seat) Stewards will guide you to your place.
4. Eucharistic Ministers will wear face masks and sanitise hands before giving out Holy Communion, we ask you if possible to receive Holy Communion on your hand. These measures are to keep everybody safe, we really look forward to welcoming you back.

**FAREWELL MASS** for the Sisters of Mercy Spanish point on Tuesday 28th July at 7pm in St. Josephs Secondary School Spanish Point.

It is with deep sadness that we learn that the Sisters of Mercy are closing their Convent in Spanish Point. It brings to an end a long connection with Spanish Point and the people of this area going back to 1929. They have left an enormous legacy in terms of Education over all those years and the wonderful school we have today is a tribute to the wonderful work and sacrifices of the sisters over all those years. In different times in Ireland their giving themselves their provisions of facilities meant that the young people in our Community were educated and given a great start. The wonderful book "Salty Faces and Ferocious Appetites" tells us about the many people who entered St. Josephs from this area and who are now leaving professionals in all walks of life in Ireland and abroad on a deeper level the legacy of kindness that Sr. Mona, Sr Angela, Sr Zita, Sr Noreen, Sr Agnes and Sister Lelia along with so many others that lingers on in the heart. In a recent piece in the Irish Times Michael Harding said "I noticed that my mother only visited the nuns when her own life was particularly troublesome." As Harding remembered with gratitude the help of Nuns is Cavan, we too remember with gratitude their help and kindness to us over all those years on this weekend we say a huge Thank You to all the sisters and we assure you that your kindness didn't go unnoticed, we are the poorer for you going. Slán go Fóil agus Míle Buiochas. We can certainly say we wont ever see your likes again in this area.
