Reflection

At the end a big fellow, whose fearful looks could have inspired fear, told me: "come to my house, I have something to honour you." I went to his house, which was a half-falling shack. He made me sit. From where I was seated the sun could be seen as it was setting. The fellow said to me: "Senor, you see how beautiful it is!" And we remained silent for some minutes. The sun disappeared. The man added: "I did not know how to_thank you for all that you have done for us. I have nothing to give you, but I thought you would like to see this sunset. It pleased you, didn't it? Good evening." He then gave me his hand. As I was leaving, I thought: "I have met very few hearts that are so kind."
