MASS TO COMMEMORATE THE GREAT FAMINE **IN KILMURRY IBRICKANE**

On Saturday next, 11th May at 7.00 pm, a special Mass will be celebrated in memory of the many victims of the Great Famine in Kilmurry Ibrickane and their curate, care-giver and advocate

Fr. Thomas Molony. The Mass forms part of the National Famine Commemoration 2013, a ten-day programme of events being held this month in West Clare, centred on the town of Kilrush. During the Great Famine the poor and starving people came from all parts of Kilmurry Ibrickane parish to Kilmurry to break stones for 8-10 hours a day. They did so in order to qualify for the meagre daily rations of food provided by the authorities and thus to avoid starvation. The Commemorative Mass will recall those traumatic times in Kilmurry Ibrickane and the efforts of Fr. Thomas Molony to comfort, support and defend the stricken people. The Mass will be held at the old parish church at Kilmurry near Quilty (weather permitting) otherwise it will be in the church in Quilty. All parishioners are

invited to attend. Parking in Jim Daly's two yards. Tea afterwards at Daly's Clonmore Lodge. Seating available in the Old Kilmurry Church.
