Did you have a miscarriage or a baby in Ireland between 1 May 1977 and 31 July 1979 or 1 March 1991 and 18 February 1994? Are you Rhesus negative? Did you receive Anti-D to prevent ‘blue baby syndrome’ during either of these periods? If your answers are ‘Yes@ and you have not already tested for Hepatitis C, then you need to contact the Irish Blood Transfusion Service (IBTS) to arrange for a Hepatitis C blood test with your local GP.
