We warmly welcome everybody back. We are concerned for the safety of everybody so at a recent Pastoral Council meeting we decided on the following safety measures:

1. Hand sanitisers are available at each church. We ask you to avail of these as you enter the Church.
  2. We ask you to adhere to social distancing by being aware of the signs on the floor.
  3. Families are welcome to sit together, two people per seat from different households (seated on either side of the seat) Stewards will guide you to your place.
  4. Eucharistic Ministers will wear face masks and sanitise hands before giving out Holy Communion, we ask you if possible to receive Holy Communion on your hand.
- These measures are to keep everybody safe, we really look forward to welcoming you back.
