factors which made that possible; the friends she made along the

SPANISH POINT COMMUNITY GROUP: Property Marking Clinic
Clare County Council and An Garda Siochána are hosting a Property
Marking Clinic at the Spanish Point Beach Carpark on Saturday
December 14th from 10 am to 4 pm. This is part of a nationwide
property marking programme which aims to combat property theft
and assist in the identification and return of stolen property. Unique
identifiers can be marked onto farm equipment, tools, computers,
electrical devices, bicycles, musical instrument cases, golf clubs and
much more. You will need to bring your property, ID (ie your
driver's licence) or your Eircode. All marking are free.

THE ADVENT WREATH

"The people who walked in darkness have seen a great
light.."

Light is the most powerful symbol of the Advent season. The
first reference to Christmas as we know it is found in a
Christian calendar of the fourth century. The feast of Jesus'
birth was celebrated by the early Christians of Rome on
December 25 to coincide with the pagan feast of Sol
Invictus—"The birthday of the unconquered Sun." The
Advent wreath dates back to ancient celebrations of the
winter solstice—that time of year when the sun reaches its
southern most point in the heavens and the days are the
darkest and most gloomy. Because they longed for the
return of the sun's light and life, the ancients stopped all
usual activity, sacrificed the use of their wagon wheels and
hung them up, festooned with lights and greens in their
celebration halls. There they awaited the return of their sun
-god, thinking of the warmth and life he brought.

The pagan feast of the Sun was adopted by the Christians to
celebrate the birth of the Son of God. The Advent Wreath is
made in the shape of a circle, to express God's unending
eternity. The evergreen symbolises God's changeableness
and our immortality. The four candles of the Advent wreath
represent the four weeks of Advent and the thousands of
years that the People of God awaited the promised Messiah.
The purple candles are a reminder of the spirit of penance
and prayer that marks the Advent season. A rose candle
used on the Third Sunday of Advent, "Gaudete Sunday"
symbolises joy and hope is awaiting Jesus' birthday. At the
beginning of Advent the wreath is blessed with holy water.
A purple candle is lighted and burns for the first week of
Advent. On successive weeks the second purple candle is
used, then the rose candle, and finally the last purple
candle. As Jesus' coming draws near, the brightness
increases.
