As you may be aware I called a Public Meeting which was held in the Parish Hall in Mullagh last Tuesday night. Following notices in our own Parish Newsletter, the Clare Champion and Clare People, I am delighted to tell you that 39 people attended. An honest, balanced and quite pragmatic debate ensued on the Slieve Callan Fund as well as the various projects that could be proposed and undertaken in the future

to enhance our Parish.

Both sides of the Slieve Callan Fund Debate were discussed but ultimately it was proposed that a decision had to be made as the other Parishes involved Miltown Malbay, Inagh- Kilnamona and Kilmaley had all moved on with their individual projects. It was made guite clear as well that if Kilmurry Ibrickane opted not to take the money, then that money would subsequently be distributed to the three other Parishes.

David Dillon and John Joe Ryan were appointed Tellers and the private vote ended decisively in favour of accepting the money. Those in Favour were 31, Against 4, Abstentions 2, Spoiled 2

Subsequently a Kilmurry-Ibrickane Development Committee was formed. It's dual purpose role will be to evaluate any proposals involving a Capitol Project that an individual or organization within the Parish would like to suggest to the Committee for Funding. More details of this procedure will become available in a few weeks time. It's other role will be to assess (independent of the Slieve Callan Fund) ways and means of developing projects in the Parish.

The Committee Members are as follows; Aoife O'Riordan, John Brew, Brian Cooney, Timmy Donnellan, Martin Sexton, Kevin Killeen, Fergal Hehir, Johnny Daly, John Talty, John O'Dwyer, Michael Considine, Aidan Moloney, Michael Talty, James Sexton, Marty Morrissey It was decided that I would act as Chairman. James Sexton as Secretary and other Officer roles could be filled in time.

The Kilmurry - Ibrickane Development Committee will meet at the beginning of February and following that meeting, the process of proposing projects for potential funding will be explained to everyone through various outlets including and primarily through our Parish Newsletter. All proposals will be welcome and will be discussed by the Committee.
