Fr. Michael Doohan

Fr. Michael was laid to rest in Dalgan, Co Meath on Wednesday last. Fr. Mick was born on 4th of March 1928 at the Hand. He was ordained a Priest in 1952. He went to the Phillipines in 1953 and was assigned to Negros where he spent sisty years working with the poor. Fr. Mick set up a school where the poor men of the area could learn to be a mechanic and lift themselves out of poverty. He was also a forerunner in caring for the planet, he was involved in planting trees on a huge scale that addresses the de-forestation that was taking place in the Phillipines at the time. Fr. Mick had a deep love for this area and for the papelo of Coare and layed to

this area and for the people of Coore and loved to come back and say mass in our Church. May his gentle soul rest in peace.
